
• **Trust** - we commit to trust others within healthy boundaries while believing the best motives.

Why have a dress code?

- Platform/stage can be the most visible place in the church.
- MODESTY is the KEY.
- We want to be a good representation of Christ and the Church.
- We want to reflect our culture but not be a distraction to anyone.
- We want to keep everyone's FOCUS on WORSHIP.

Basic Worship Team Color Rules:

Reglas de los: Colores Básicos en Nuestro Equipo

- Do(s):
- Black, Gray, Beige, whites are always acceptable.
- Neutral Colors
- Small Patterns, nothing too flashy
- Don't(s):
- Bright colors (Bright yellows, reds, oranges)
- See through clothing
- No graphic T-shirts

• Recomendado:

- Colores Negros, Grises, Blancos siempre son aceptables.
- Colores Neutrales
- Patrones pequeñas en la ropa, nada llamativo

No Recomendado:

- No colores llamativos (Amarillos, rojos, naranjos).
- Géneros transparentes
- No camisetas con gráficos









Guys

Muchachos

- Make sure shirts are buttoned in the appropriate places.
- Make sure your shirt is not too tight and is the appropriate length.
- Pants should not cup or conform to the front or back of your body.
- Asegúrate que las camisas estén abotonadas en los lugares correctos.
- Asegúrate que tus camisas no estén muy ajustadas y estén al largo apropiado.
- Los pantalones no pueden ser muy justos en la parte de al frente y atrás.









Gals... Chicas..

- Layers are encouraged. Scarf, vest, sweater, leggings, jackets.
- Consider sleeve and skirt length.
 - Sleeveless and capped sleeves are not allowed.
 - Skirts should be knee-length or longer
 - Remember you are standing 4'-5' above the congregation so when in doubt, go longer.
- The fabric should be thick enough, so backlighting doesn't reveal any silhouette.
- Se anima el uso de diferentes capas de ropa. Bufanda, chaleco, suéter, leggings, chaquetas, pañuelo de bolsillo, etc.
- Considere la longitud de la manga y la falda.
 - No se permiten camisas sin mangas o mangas cortas. Preferiblemente a la altura del codo.
 - Las faldas deben llegar a la rodilla o más largas.
 - Recuerde que está parado 4'-5' por encima de la congregación, así que en caso de duda, escoja algo más largo.
 - La tela de su ropa debe ser lo sumamente grueso para que las luces no revelen la silueta debajo.

Last few reminders...

Algunos pequeños recordatorios..

- Always do a final WORSHIP MIRROR CHECK.
 - Raise your arms as high as you can and swing them in all directions.
 - Look in the mirror and check yourself from all angles make sure you are not revealing anything inappropriate.
 - Kneel down and check to see if the back of your pants comes too low or uncovers anything.
 - Lean forward, see if your shirt reveals anything.
 - Check the tightness in your pants in the back and the front
- If you are ever unsure about an item, you may email or text our Worship Staff to ask about your concern or send a picture of the outfit.
- Siempre haga una COMPROBACIÓN FINAL FRENTE AL ESPEJO
 - Levante los brazos lo más alto que pueda y muévalos en todas las direcciones.
 - Mírese en el espejo y observe desde todos los ángulos; asegúrese de no revelar nada inapropiado.
 - Arrodíllese y verifique si la parte de atrás de sus pantalones baja demasiado o descubre algo.
 - Inclínese hacia adelante, y vea si su camisa revela algo.
 - Verifique la entrepierna de sus pantalones en la parte posterior y delantera.
- Si alguna vez no está seguro acerca de un artículo, puede enviar un correo electrónico a su Líder de Alabanza con su pregunta o foto del atuendo.





Modesty and style are important, so we give focus on worship, not us, and still come across as relevant to our culture and the people we are leading. Read up on modern styles and balance them with classic pieces. We never want to be a distraction because of what we have on, and we certainly don't want to draw any attention towards us. Let's put all the focus on the Lord.
